#### **Teaching Strategies**

For passionate teachers, education is a continual learning process, not just for students but for the teachers as well. To teach and care for children in an inspirational way that is understanding of all students' needs; .to provide leadership in the class room; and to keep abreast of new technology and new teaching strategies. I try to use different plans time to time according to the topic.

- ❖ Try to find different ways to teach a new lesson or concept. To ensure more students are grasping new concepts and lessons, try applying a variety of ways to present topic effectively.
- ❖ Approachable. I always present a friendly, approachable environment so that students can feel comfortable reaching out for assistance when they need it. I offer them open office hours to meet with them in private for any questions or concerns that they might have.
- ❖ Make learning fun. By making my English lessons fun and engaging, my students are more motivated to learn the subject matter. Some ways that I make learning fun include playing games and turning activities into contests with positive reinforcements like prizes or additional game time.
- ❖ Integrate reading and writing vocabulary throughout the lesson. I provide the students enough time, to practice and review words.
- ❖ Use a team approach, which includes the students in the planning process. As oral presentation involves speaker and audience relationship so to develop good rapport I give chance for discussing goals and priorities, as well as developing strategies that can be applied in different settings that help the student to make the most effective presentation.
- **Learn from errors**-If a student makes an error when speaking then I repeat what the student said providing the correct model without directly drawing attention to the error.
- ❖ Questioning I keep trying to ask more open-ended questions to my students and give them chance to share their ideas with each other.
- ❖ Increase verbal interaction I provide opportunities to increase verbal interaction in classroom activities to help ensure that students are exposed to as many different types of authentic language as possible and allow students opportunities to practice using the target language. Planning for more group and pair work during lessons help to do this.
- **Challenge the students.** I give the students challenges and tasks such as drills, open ended questions, puzzles with each new lesson.
