Level 7 course	Nutrition Assessment (321CLN)
Course description	The course is designed to teach the basic nutritional concepts of clinical nutrition. Nutritional assessment is employed to rapidly classify individuals or population groups at risk of becoming malnourished and conclude the impact of nutritional program. The students will be able to assess a patient's nutritional status during health as well as during acute and chronic illness.

Level 7 course	Clinical Nutritional I (341CLN)
Course description	This course examines the relationship between nutrition and the prevention and treatment of diseases. It explores the nutritional aspects of various diseases and clinical disorders by integrating students' existing knowledge of physiology, biochemistry, and food science.

Level 7 course	Nutritional Biochemistry (351CLN)
Course description	This course is tailored for students in the Clinical Nutrition Department, with a primary focus on fundamental biochemistry concepts. It places strong emphasis on understanding the organization and analysis of nutritional biochemistry.
