Level 9 course	Food Safety and Hygiene (312CLN)
Course description	This course will outline the importance of food safety procedures, safe food handling, and behavior to reduce contamination risks by following hygiene practices.

Level 9 course	Community Nutrition (331CLN)
Course description	This course provides students with sufficient knowledge and skills necessary to conduct effective community nutrition programs. Other topics covered include food and nutrition policies and legislation, nutrition monitoring, and food assistance programs.

Level 9 course	Enteral and Parenteral Nutrition (344CLN)
Course description	In this course, alternate modes of feeding to provide nutrition support for patients with special needs are studied. Ways of feeding when the gastrointestinal tract still is used (Enteral nutrition); as well as nutrients feeding directly into a vein when gastrointestinal tract cannot be used (Parenteral nutrition) are explained. Enteral and parenteral support formulas, solutions and delivery system for use in hospitals and homes are also included in the course.
