The Unit organized workshops under the supervision of the dean of University College Al Ardha. The presentation was conducted in University college of Al Ardha as well as online via Zoom.

The first workshop was conducted in University college of Al Ardha. The part one is entitled “**What are Electronic Learning Outcomes**”, presented by MS. Tayyiba Asim on Tuesday, 25/08/2020. The purpose of this workshop was to explain, how to identify program learning outcomes and aligned them with electronic learning to develop the assessment methods and plans in report writing. Then what are the assessment plans for future improvement. How can we relate our course learning outcomes with that of the Jazan University outcomes, which are embedded with the SAFQ (Saudi Arabia Framework Qualification).

In workshop Jazan University’s learning outcomes were discussed in relation to the program’s learning outcomes and the assessment methods were discussed in order to achieve the vision mission of Jazan University.

The second workshop was also conducted in University college of Al Ardha. The workshop is entitled “**Achievements of Electronic Learning Outcomes**”, presented by MS. Tayyiba Asim on Wednesday, 26/08/2020. The purpose of this workshop was to explain, how to achieve learning outcomes through electronic education. Then what are the important steps for future improvement. How can we relate our course learning outcomes with that of the Jazan University outcomes?

In third workshop entitled with “**Achieving the Target of Learning outcomes in eLearning Environment**” which was discussed in relation to the program’s learning outcomes and the assessment methods were discussed in order to achieve the vision mission of Jazan University. The participants gave a positive feedback about the workshops and suggested they would like to further participate in such workshops. The workshop was held on 15-10-2020.

In forth workshop entitled with “**Teaching and learning materials**” in which different types of teaching and learning materials were discussed along with the use and importance of the materials especially in online classes. Also different types of strategies were discussed which can create an effective classroom environment. At the end it was discussed that teaching and learning materials are not a complete method of teaching but an aid to learning. Teaching and learning materials should be adapted to the understanding and level of the class. Teaching and learning materials should be relevant to the subject of the lesson. The workshop was held on 22-10-2020.



In the last workshop entitled with “**Innovation and Creativity in Classroom Teaching**” which was held on 18-11-2020, different types of creative teaching and learning ideas were discussed along with the use and importance of the creative materials especially in online classes. Also different types of tools and strategies were discussed which can create an amusing classroom environment.

Workshop was ended by discussing that teaching and learning materials should be adapted to the understanding and level of the class. Creative teaching is an art, and some strategies may help to promote creative thinking, but teachers need to develop a full repertoire of skills which they can adapt to different situations.

The workshops were attended by the faculty members of departments of Physics, Physiotherapy and English. The participants were enthusiastic during the workshops and participated actively in the discussion. They shared their insights on the topics and challenges they faced when dealing with LO statements. The participants gave a positive feedback about the workshops and suggested they would like to further participate in such workshops.
