



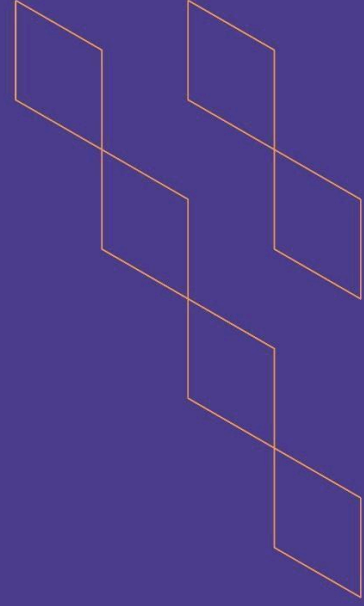

Introduction

Performance indicators are important tools for evaluating the quality of academic programs and following up on their performance, and they contribute to continuous development and decision-making support.

The National Center for Academic Accreditation and Assessment has identified 11 main indicators to follow up on performance at the programmatic level, all of which are consistent with the 2022 program accreditation standards , and these indicators are the minimum required to be measured periodically, and additional performance indicators can be used if the program deems it necessary to ensure quality. The program is expected to measure key performance indicators with benchmarking using appropriate tools, such as: (opinion polls, statistical data ... According to the nature and objective of each indicator, as well as determining the following values for each index:

- Actual performance level
- Target performance level
- Internal reference performance level (internal benchmarking)
- External reference performance level (external reference comparison)
- New Target Performance Level

This results in a report to describe and analyze the results of each indicator (including performance changes and comparisons according to location and gender of students), and

an accurate and objective identification of strengths and areas for improvement.
